II. Read Romans 8:6-11

6 Now the mind-set of the flesh is death, but the mind-set of the Spirit is life and peace.

7 The mind-set of the flesh is hostile to God because it does not submit to God's law. Indeed, it is unable to do so.

8 Those who are in the flesh cannot please God.

9 You, however, are not in the flesh, but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you. If anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he does not belong to him. 10 Now if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit gives life because of righteousness.

11 And if the Spirit of him who raised Jesus from the dead lives in you, then he who raised Christ from the dead will also bring your mortal bodies to life through his Spirit who lives in you.

- 20 As soon as Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she went to meet him, but Mary remained seated in the house.
- 21 Then Martha said to Jesus, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother wouldn't have died.
- 22 Yet even now I know that whatever you ask from God, God will give you."
- 23 "Your brother will rise again," Jesus told her.
- 24 Martha said to him, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection at the last day."
- 25 Jesus said to her, "I am the resurrection and the life. The one who believes in me, even if he dies, will live.
- 26 Everyone who lives and believes in me will never die. Do you believe this?" 27 "Yes, Lord," she told him, "I believe you are the Messiah, the Son of God, who comes into the world."
